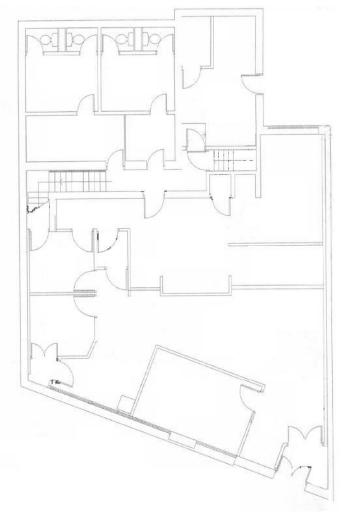




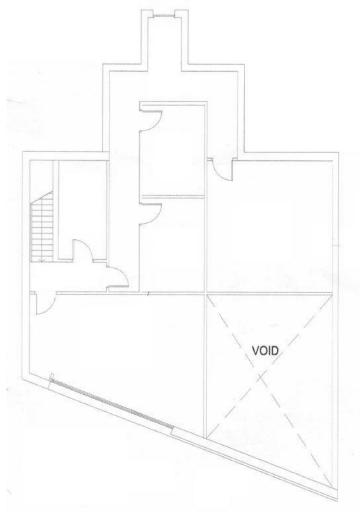








GROUND FLOOR
